Residents living with dementia enjoy everything from nostalgic wartime songs to lively hits by Rod Stewart and Bob Marley. Seasonal events, like autumnal harvest-themed arts and crafts or visits from Mayflower Primary School for Christmas carols, bring a sense of celebration and connection to the home.

The tropical fish in the lounge provides a soothing background, while visiting animals like dogs, guinea pigs, and cockatiels bring smiles and moments of joy. Residents also love engaging with the pets, watching their antics, and even helping to care for them.

Whether it's enjoying a day at the local pub for lunch, visiting the dementia café at the library, or participating in armchair exercises, every day offers opportunities to celebrate life, build connections, and create lasting memories.
