The gardens at Moorland House are a cherished space for residents, offering a peaceful retreat for relaxation and activity.

Spanning both the front and back of the property, the landscaped grounds include a summer house and plenty of seating areas where residents can enjoy the fresh air and views of the surrounding countryside.

During warmer months, the gardens come alive with events like the annual summer fete, featuring live music, craft stalls, and cream teas. Gardening projects with local Cubs and Brownies add vibrancy to the space, as residents and young visitors alike work together to plant flowers and tend to the grounds.

Whether it's a quiet moment with tea in the summer house or participating in a community event, the gardens at Moorland House are a source of joy and connection for all.
